



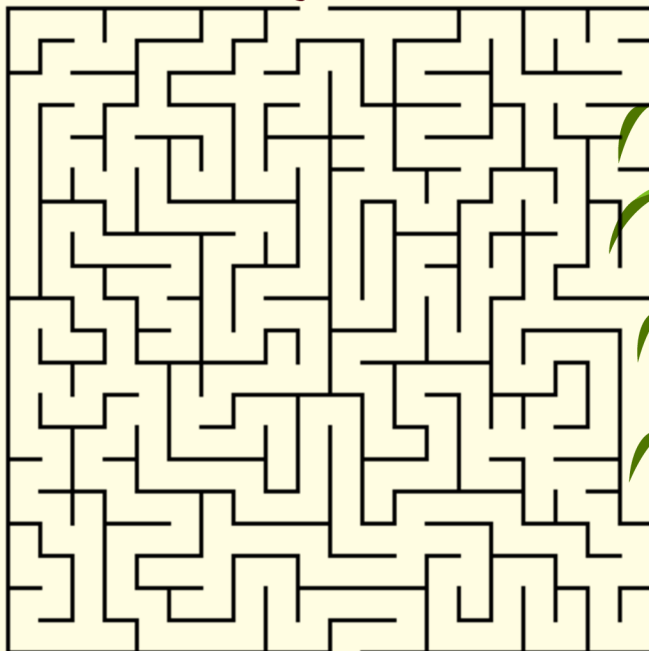
The Three Sisters
